Tuition Information

At Cambridge College, you pay for your courses when you register for them. Tuition cost is currently \$405 per credit hour. During your first term, you will register for:

EIM 610 Individualized Planning Seminar	3 Credits	\$1,215
EIH 620 Introduction to Humane Education	4 Credits	\$1,620

A point of clarification: Part of your Individualized Planning Seminar (EIM 610) will be conducted via telephone with a faculty advisor. The Individualized Planning Seminar also includes a required residency week held in Surry, Maine (at IHE), which will be offered during the spring and fall semesters each year.

There is a one-time administrative fee of \$500 also payable to Cambridge College. Therefore, total tuition due at the time of registration is \$3,335.

The following is a complete list of requirements and credit hours. The five courses that comprise your concentration coursework are marked with an asterisk (*) below. In addition to these courses, you are required to complete an individualized planning seminar, a practicum, a course in research methods, and an independent learning project.

At the end of the program, there is a \$110 graduation fee payable to Cambridge College. Therefore, total tuition for the program is: \$13,570.

We estimate the total cost of purchasing books for the whole program, along with the cost of borrowing video/DVDs, to be \$750. This is based on purchasing new books at current list prices. If you purchase used books, it should be less.
