### Try Before You Apply!

Start our certificate program BEFORE you apply! Take up to two courses before committing to the entire program.

**To Register:** There is no application. Visit our registrar online:

<http://humaneeducation.org/store/courses> and pay for your course online. Before your register online for this course, please be sure to log into your IHE account first (<http://humaneeducation.org/login>). If you don't already have an IHE account, you can set one up here: <http://humaneeducation.org/users/edit>. When we receive your registration, we'll confirm receipt and your faculty member will contact you to begin!

**Humane Education Certificate Program (HECP):** If you should decide to enroll in the entire Humane Education Certificate Program (HECP), your course work will apply to your work in the HECP.

**Applicable Courses:** We suggest that you take one or both of the first two courses in the Certificate Program sequence (Introduction to Humane Education and/or Environmental Ethics), but you can take any courses in the Certificate Program that you like, including Animal Protection, Human Rights or Culture and Change. **Course Structure:** Each student reads from an extensive list of books for each course, watches documentary videos/DVDs, and completes written assignments that you submit to your faculty member throughout the course or at the end. The course includes monthly mentoring of about one hour per month by phone or email (or as needed), assignment mentoring, review and commentary by faculty, and online classroom access with faculty and fellow students in both the M. Ed and Certificate Program.

**Tuition:** Tuition is \$600 per course.

#### **Additional Fees:**

Additional fees include:

- Books
- Course pack with required articles
- Cost of borrowing the required documentary videos/DVDs

A sample book list and video list are available by request. Many of the books are available via library (either directly from your library or through interlibrary loan). Some of the DVDs may be available through your library, many are available online for free, and some are available through Netflix. Videos and DVDs borrowed from IHE cost about \$10 each for all

shipping, handling and insurance. The cost of the course pack is directly related to the cost of copyright for the required articles, and averages \$50-60 per course.

**Time Commitment:** You can take one course at a time, or two simultaneously, but you should plan to complete each course within a four-month timeframe.
